So what is the role of the family and community nurse?


Process owner in collaboration with the general practitioner: they

take charge of the patient, his caregiving system and his support environment for an undefined time provide a solid basis for patients on their territory, where they can find answers to different health needs

identify and activate health and social professionals according to the needs of the patients, his family or community

The changing of a paradigm

Prevention becomes essential in the new model. We move from a "passive" model where, the provision of care takes place only at the moment when the patient is sick, to an "active» model, capable of intervening before the acute event, where we try to prevent the disease or its aggravation, maintaining or improving patients, family and community conditions of fragility.
